MRS. A. J. WAGGONER, CERRO GORDO, DIES

Mrs. Albert J. (Ara) Waggoner, 61, of Cerro Gordo died unexpectedly in her home at 6:15 a. m. today.

A member of Cerro Gordo Methodist Church, Mrs. Waggoner had lived in Decatur all her life before moving to Cerro Gordo two years ago.
