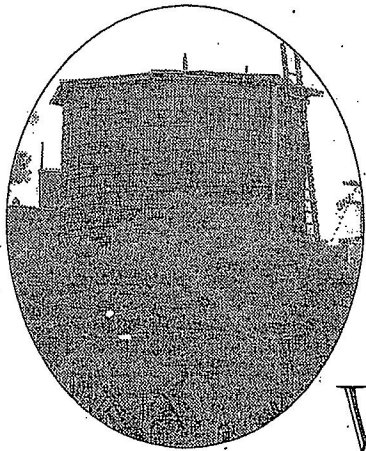


Be a part of the Restoration of the



HISTORIC CENTRALIA RAILROAD WATER TOWER

Help restore the historic Centralia Railroad Water Tower in celebrating the city's sesquicentennial in 2003 by donating to the restoration fund or by honoring a railroader (past or present).

Centralia was founded and named in 1853 by the Illinois Central Railroad, and the water tower which provided water for the old steam engines is our only remaining relic of that era. The Water Tower Restoration Committee is seeking local funds in order to apply for state grants to achieve the preservation of this historic structure.

A very limited number of spaces remain on the Wall of Honor.

Direct donations may be made to the fund or individuals may donate \$50 to honor a railroader (past or present). Honored railroaders' names will be placed on a plaque on the Railroaders Wall of Honor which has been installed at the new Centralia depot.
